 - 4. For every 30 minutes of reading, earn one entry into the prize drawing.
- 5. Bonus entries: Each library program you attend gives you one more entry.



- 1. Eligibility: Anyone with a W.H. Walters Free Public Library card can join. Don't have one? Sign up at the library!
- 2. Sign-up & Log Submission: To joint the Fall into Winter Reading Challenge, sign up and send in your reading/activity log by emailing it to alphapubliclibrary1@outlook.com or dropping it off at the library.
- 3. Track Your Progress: Use the downloadable reading/activity log to keep track of your reading. Make sure to submit all your reading and activities to earn entries into the prize drawing.
- 4. Earning Entries: For every 30 minutes of reading, you'll earn one entry into the prize drawing.
- 5. Bonus Entries: You can earn extra entries by attending library programs. Each program you attend gives you one more entry.
- 6. Log Submission Period: You can submit and update your reading/activity log between November 3, 2025 and January 5, 2026.
- 7. Deadline: All entries must be received by 11:59pm on January 5, 2026. No entries will be accepted after this time.
- 8. Prize Drawing: The drawing will take place the week of January 12, 2026, and winners will be notified by January 23, 2026.
- 9. W.H. Walters Free Public Library employees are not eligible to win prizes.
