  - Week 1: 3/16-3/22 = Elite 8
  - Week 2: 3/23-3/29 = Semifinals
  - Week 3: 3/30-4/3 = Final Four
  - April 5<sup>th</sup> = Book winner announced for all 4 brackets.

## Voting:

- Physical Voting: a voting jar and slips of paper will be in the library near the circulation desk. The books will be on display, and the brackets will be hung up in the library.
- Online Voting: A Google Form will be posted on our library's website and Facebook page. If for some reason, you cannot access the link, you can always email the library with your vote.

## Deadlines:

- Week 2: Votes must be in by 6pm on 3/29
- Week 3: Votes must be in by 6pm on 4/3
  - The winner will be announced at 11am on 4/5.
