How to Participate:


- Vote for your favorite books in our March Madness bracket. There will be 4 brackets

- Online Voting: A Google Form will be posted on our library's website and Facebook page. If for some reason, you cannot access the link, you can always email the library with your vote.


Deadlines:

 - The winner will be announced at 11am on 4/5.






